




Total intimidation visually but elevated tee helps the hole play shorter. Just pick your club, make a smooth swing and you will have a putt at birdie.

11 Tricky double dogleg. Favor the right side for best angle into this sloping green.



Keep the driver in the bag and use a long iron or fairway wood. This should leave a short to middle iron into a well guarded green._






The toughest part of this hole is the threetiered green that is narrow and deep. Not an easy up and down if you miss.



15 Longest hole on the course looks narrow from the tee but there is more room than you

Accuracy is a must or you will have tree trouble. Small green will offer a good birdie try when you reach it.







Beautiful finishing hole with a steep slope in front of the green. Take plenty of club.



Tee shot of 200 yards on the right side will leave an open approach to the green and short of the fairway bunker.

2 Make sure you take less club to allow for the elevation. Par is difficult from the woods behind green.




Great stra room all ti

Great straightaway par 5. Right side has more **3** room all the way and accuracy is needed to narrow green.


4 Difficult dogleg left that finishes with a twotiered elevated green. Favor right side off the tee but watch out for the bunker.



Elevated tee provides a beautiful view of this classy par 4. Longer hitters will get in trouble with the tree on the left side.



Tee it high and hit a solid shot. Once you reach the top of the ridge you will find a large, inviting green.



Back up the ridge again. Take one more club and favor the right side to avoid the bunker and get a nice bounce off the slope.




Good tee shot is rewarded with a chance to reach the green in two. A missed approach to the right is better than a penalty stroke.
